

3 Adaptive Technologies

The provision of devices, aids, controls, appliances or supplies of either communication or adaptive type determined necessary to enable the person to increase his or her ability to function with independence and safety skills in a home and community based setting.

4 Advocacy

Advocacy services help persons with developmental disabilities and their families obtain the rights and privileges to which they are entitled.

5 After Day/After School Program (Respite)

These respite programs serve school age children for two to three hours a day, from one to five days per week, and offer social, recreational, educational and enrichment activities.

7 Counseling/Training

Skills training for individuals with disabilities
Training and/or counseling for parents who are DD.
Training and /or counseling for parents or siblings
of individuals with developmental disabilities.

11 Crisis Intervention/Behavior Modification

Emergency short term assistance to families experiencing life stresses and problems while Supporting a person with a developmental disability at home. Professional staff, behavior modification, emergency services and support are provided.

13 Day Camp/Summer Day Camp (Respite)

Social, recreational, educational and enrichment activities.

15 Environmental Modifications

Selected internal and external changes to the person's physical home environment, which are necessary to ensure the health, welfare and safety of the person and to enable him or her to function with greater independence in the home.

16 Family Reimbursement

These programs provide subsidy to families to pay for specific goods and services that are not funded by any another program

20 Financial Counseling

Financial assistance programs help families obtain financial benefits and entitlements.

21 In-Home Respite

This program provides relief in the home to families who care for family members with DD as scheduled

24 Information & Referral

Information is provided about programs and service.

25 Non-Medicaid Service Coordination

Short term case management is provided for individuals who do not have Medicaid. Advocacy, referral, educational And entitlement assistance are provided.

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27 Non Medicaid Evaluations

Psychological and Psychosocial Assessments are provided to determine OPWDD eligibility for those without Medicaid.

28 Out of Home Respite

Respite services provided in the community in a variety of settings to provide relief to families.

29 Outreach

Outreach services to educate the community about existing services and connecting them to services.

30 Overnight Respite

Respite provided overnight in a variety of

Social, recreations, trips, educational and enrichment activities.

Respite services provided in or out of the home during legal holidays.

INTRODUCTION

This is a comprehensive listing of all programs in Queens that are funded by the New York State Office For People With Developmental Disabilities (OPWDD) through Family Support Services Contracts and administered by the local Bernard Fineson Developmental Disabilities Regional Office, Region 4 (BFDDRO). Also included are Family Support programs funded by New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene.

These programs serve developmentally disabled individuals and their families. The developmentally disabled in order to use these programs the individual must reside with his or her family in Queens County. Developmental Disabilities include Intellectually Challenged, Neurological Impairment, Epilepsy, Cerebral Palsy, Down's Syndrome, Traumatic Brain Injuries and Autism, among others.

Family Support Programs are designed to strengthen the delivery of support services to families caring for disabled family members at home so as to maintain and stabilize the family unit, and to reduce the potential for out-of-home placement.
