#### **SUMMARY OF ADULT DAY SERVICES**

<u>Day Habilitation/Day Hab without Walls (WOW)</u>: This is a service that provides a range of supervised experiences in community settings designed to meet an individual's unique choices and needs. Activities in this type of program may include purchasing goods and services, volunteering in the community, learning to travel in the community, and preparation for the possibility of eventually entering the job market in a supported work endeavor. In Day Hab without walls the same needs of the individual are met in a unique way by providing them in their community.

<u>Community Pre-Vocational Services</u>: This is a service that prepares individuals for paid or unpaid employment. Services include teaching concepts such as attending to task, task completion, problem solving, and safety. Activities included in this category are not primarily directed at teaching specific job skills, but are directed at underlying goals, such as increased attention span and/or improving motor skills.

<u>Supported Employment - SEMP:</u> These are services designed to enable adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities to secure and maintain gainful employment in their community. Services may include, but are not limited to: vocational assessment to accurately determine the proper vocational course of action, on-the-job placement working with job coaching, and vocational counseling supports. Transitional employment programs, supported employment programs, and workstations in the industry are examples of programs. Supported Employment is for individuals who because of their disability cannot gain competitive employment on their own or cannot maintain the job independently.

**Work Readiness:** These services address issues of occupational exploration, job hunting techniques, interviewing and the behaviors necessary to hold a job. A significant component is devoted to individual participation in community-based work internships. Staff works directly with each individual at a work site to further assess their work skills, preferences, and support needs. Considerable time is spent on training individuals to travel independently to work locations. The final phase of the program involves individualized job placement with intensive job coaching services. The coaching helps each participant learn work tasks and appropriate work behaviors. Coaching continues as needed to ensure job retention.

<u>Pathway to Employment:</u> These services offer an individualized planning process that helps individuals who are interested in obtaining employment with identifying a career or vocational direction. Staff provides instruction and training in job readiness skills as well as working with the individual in developing a plan for achieving competitive, integrated employment at or above New York State minimum wage. The outcome of this service is preparing proper a detailed of the individual's stated career objective that is used to guide their supports and prepare them for Supported Employment within 12 months.

**Employee Training Program (ETP):** These services offer an opportunity to work at an internship with the result of leading to permanent employment in a community business. During the internship period, the individual will be paid wages through ETP while they are learning skills that are necessary for the job. Participants also attend work readiness classes that discuss such topics as conflict resolution, and proper work attire. Services also include increased job development, provided job coaching and assistance with additional employability skills.

**Family Support Services:** These programs are designed to strengthen the delivery of support services to families caring for family members with a disability so as to maintain, stabilize the family unit and to reduce the potential for out of home placement. Services include, but are not limited to: in home respite, overnight respite, crisis intervention services, family reimbursement, home equipment repair and modifications, recreational programs, camp programs and outreach.

<u>Self- Directed Services:</u> Through this option the individual is in control of every service they request or obtain, including making important decisions about their staff and services with assistance of available supports. This allows them to manage all aspects of service delivery and encourages the person centered planning process.

<u>Community Habilitation:</u> Through Community Habilitation, individuals that live either at home independently or with family are given an opportunity to learn and experience community-based activities. The individual is able to learn how to complete these activities with assistance to focus on social skill-building, developing skills for daily and community living, behavior stabilization, and health education. Community Habilitation is available to those who do not reside in a residence that certified or operated by OPWDD.
